

The outdoor exhibition "KL Plaszow. A Site After, a Site Without"

The area of KL Plaszow memorial site is a real testimony of victims' death and suffering, and the key to understanding the history of the former camp.

On 15 March, we will open the area with a new outdoor exhibition to visitors. The outdoor exhibition "KL Plaszow. A Site After, a Site Without" is designed principally as the first and permanently accessible guide to the KL Plaszow memorial site. Arranged in the post-camp area, the exhibition shows the layout and describes the history of the former camp, enabling the visitor to find in the today's space the locations of events described. Each board consists of a historical text, fragments of accounts given by former prisoners, and historical photographs. These materials on display at the exhibition are complemented by arranging: 41 featured points and 3 unearthed artefacts known as archaeological windows.

In the future, the presentation of topics addressed at the outdoor exhibition will be complemented by two branches of a permanent exhibition, to be displayed in the historical Grey House and the planned Memorial building.
